Directions:

From the East:

Take Interstate 195 West to Exit 3 (Gano Street). At the end of the exit, turn Left onto Gano Street. Turn Right onto Wickenden Street. Immediately after the Vartan Gregorian Elementary School, turn Left onto East Street. Tockwotton Home is on the corner of East Street and George M. Cohan Boulevard.

From the North, South, and West:

Take Interstate 195 East to Exit 2 (Wickenden Street). At the end of exit there will be a traffic light; turn Left onto Wickenden Street. After continuing through two more lights, take the fourth street on the Right (East Street), immediately before the Vartan Gregorian Elementary School. Tockwotton Home is on the corner of East Street and George M. Cohan Boulevard.
